Expos are the world's largest exhibitions, organised cyclically and presenting the cultural, scientific and technical achievements of the world's countries, nations, societies and communities.

Together with people from across the world they create meaningful impact through a range of programmes and initiatives.

There are two basic types of World Fairs. Every five years, a World (Universal) EXPO is organised, encompassing universal themes.

## London / United Kingdom 1851

The Great Exhibition in London was held in the iconic Crystal Palace in 1851 to showcase the inventions of the Industrial Revolution.

## Paris / France 1889

The main symbol of the Fair was the Eiffel Tower. It was not immediately popular and some campaigned for its dismantling after the exposition closed

A new railway station was constructed for Expo, a new network of urban roads was created, the tram network was extended, and a third terminal was constructed at the city airport.
